Plastic Bags, Newspaper Bags & Dry Cleaning Bags: Bring back to participating retailers for recycling **Clothing:** Donate to a thrift store or local drop box Metal Hangers: Bring back to dry cleaner **Books:** Donate or remove covers before recycling Electronics & Batteries: Bring to the HHW Facility SHARPS & Medical Waste: Call 364-2086 or 364-2175

Additional Items: Plastic bags, hangers, appliances, toys, ceramic tableware, glass windows, large plastic or metal items, clothing, containers that held a hazardous substance, soiled paper, paper cups-napkins-paper towels, paper with layers of foil or plastic, hard covered books, SHARPS, trash, items not listed as acceptable



Tips for Great Recycling!

Do rinse your containers before recycling Do put only acceptable items in your recycling bins **Do** put your bins out for collection the night before **Do** leave caps and labels on...they're acceptable Do place shredded paper in paper bags only Do flatten cardboard boxes before recycling Don't place recyclables in plastic bags Don't place plastic bags in your recycling bins Don't put metal or plastic hangers in recycling bins Don't place soiled recyclables in your bins
