Reminders

Overnight parking is prohibited in the Village all year long. No vehicles may be parked on any public street from 2:00 AM to 6:00 AM. For the months of April through November temporary overnight parking permits can be obtained at the Village office at the discretion of the Village Clerk.

Trash bins should be left at the house, next to the garage. Bulk items and recycling bins must be left at the curb. All bins should be put out for collection by 6:00 AM on pickup day. Please do not leave bins at the curb on non-pickup days.

Hazardous materials should not be put out with your trash or brought to Village Hall. Hazardous waste and electronics may be dropped off at the Rockland County Solid Waste Authority at the Fire Training Center in Pomona. The facility is open from 8:00 AM to 1:00 PM Monday through Friday and some weekends. See

The Village noise law allows construction equipment to be used only during the hours of 8:00 AM to 9:00 PM on weekdays, and 10:00 AM to 6:00 PM on weekends and legal holidays. See the entire law for more details on the Documents page of the Village website at:

Before doing any type of construction, call the Village and speak with the Building Department to find out if any permits are required (845-354-0400). After your project is complete make sure to call the Village to schedule a final inspection to get your certificate of occupancy.

New Committee

In these tough economic times, the Village is interested in what we can do to support the small businesses of Village residents. To that end, the Village is forming a committee to come up with ideas that can be implemented by the Village Board. Trustee Marshall Katz, who will be chairing the committee, is looking to sit down with Village residents to generate and discuss ideas. One suggestion already submitted is a reexamination of the Village's sign law to allow various types of contractors to display lawn signs for longer periods than currently allowed. If you would like to serve on the committee please let Trustee Katz know. The time commitment for those who volunteer for the committee will most likely be limited to 1 or 2 meetings. No Left Turns

Please remember that you may not make a left turn into the Wesley Plaza shopping center when travelling north on Route 306. This is a very important safety issue that was put into effect to prevent the many accidents and near misses at the intersection of Village Green and Route 306. In the near future, families will be moving into the new homes across from the shopping center. It is important that everyone abide by the traffic rules associated with Greg Sikorsky Drive, the street that goes into the new development, opposite the main entrance to the shopping center. You are not allowed to cross Route 306 to go from the shopping center to Greg Sikorsky Drive, or vice versa. In addition, you may only make a right turn when exiting Greg Sikorsky Drive, and you may only enter when travelling north on Route 306. You are not allowed to make a left turn into this street when travelling south on Route 306. To get into the development when travelling southbound on Route 306, you must make a left at East Willow Tree Road and enter from Willows Road. All of the above rules were put into effect for the safety of our residents. Please abide by these rules to avoid unnecessary traffic citations. Thank you for your cooperation.

Residential uses

Many residents may be unaware of some of the rules regarding two family homes and home businesses in the Village. The Village zoning code allows for single family homes only. You may rent out a portion of your home to a single unrelated boarder, as long as there is not a physically separated living space, or separate cooking facilities. Other than that, you may not have multiple unrelated families living in a home, and you may not alter the structure of a home so that there are multiple physically separate living spaces that are not shared.

Certain types of home businesses are allowed in the Village. Businesses that do not generate any trips to the home by non-residents are allowed with no permit required. Businesses that do generate trips require a special use permit issued by the Planning Board.

For information on all the rules and requirements, please see the <u>Village Zoning</u> <u>Code</u> on the Documents page of our website and refer to the descriptions for Home occupations and Home businesses.

These are quality of life issues which we need to keep in check if we want to maintain the Village that we all love. If you have any questions about either of the above issues, please call the Village office and speak to the building department to find out what is allowed, and when a permit is needed.

It will usually be delivered within 24 hours to the locker in front of the Village Hall. Enter the last 7 digits of your library card, and the locker with your items will pop open.
