- ⇒ Cardboard and bottles must be separated

Brush / Leaves / Grass Clippings

⇒ Brush / Leaves / Grass Clippings must be placed in the designated **Biodegradable Bags** provided by the Village, it cannot be in garbage

bags or any other type of bags -

Please do not mix them together



⇒ Brush / branches for collection must be tied in no more than 4ft. length bundles



Some information regarding Bulk

Requirements

- Bulk items must be placed at the curb for collection
- Collection begins at 6am
- No more than 5 Bulk item per set out

Items Not Included

- Construction & Demolition Debris, Grass, Brush, Leaves, Tires, Paint, E-Waste, Hazards Materials, Bulky Scrap Metals

Construction & Demolition Debris

⇒ **Only** Minor Do It Yourself (DIY) Home Repair Debris will be collected if:

1. Materials do not exceed 5ft in length
2. Materials do not exceed 50lbs per bundle
3. 2 Bundles are set out per collection date

- NO CONTRACTOR DEBRIS WILL BE COLLECTED -

Collection Schedule

<u>Solid Waste Component</u>	<u>Collection Frequency</u>	<u>Days</u>
Garbage	Twice Per Week	Mon & Thurs or Tues & Fri
Bulky Items	Once Per Week	Second pick up day each week
Scrap Metal	Once Per Week	Second pick up day each week
Leaves	Four Times Per Year	June 17, July 15, Oct 28, Dec 2,
Grass Clippings	Four Times Per Year	June 24, July 22, Oct 21 Nov 8
Brush	Four Times Per Year	June 10, July 8, Nov 4, Dec 9
Commingled Containers	Once Per Week	Wednesday
Commingled Paper	Once Per Week	Wednesday
